Fall Board 2017 Update:

The Washington JCI Senate is looking forward to having you all experience the Water, Wine and WOW of Washington at Fall Board 2017 September 14-17.

We've had a couple of questions about this meeting and the tours we have planned, so I thought I would answer them here:

- 1 - What airport do I fly into? Pasco (PSC) is the closest airport, less than 1/2 mile from the hotel. Seattle (SEA) is a 4 hours drive, Spokane (GEG) is a 3 hour drive and Portland (PDX) is 2-1/2 to 3 hour drive. If you fly into a different airport and drive in, parking is free at the hotel. If you fly into Pasco, the hotel can shuttle you back to the airport if you want to rent a car for a day to do some exploring on your own.
- 2 - When do I need to arrive? If you want to do the Round Up Thursday and anything else Friday, you will need to arrive on Wednesday. Hotel rates are good 2 days before and 2 days after the event.

3 - How many tickets do you have for the Pendleton Round-Up? We currently have 25 tickets for Thursday and 50 tickets for Friday on hold with the PRU ticketing office. To ensure that you get a ticket the day you want to go, you MUST register by August 1st. After that date, we can't guarantee that you will have a ticket.

We will be updating the registration form on the National Website with the Round-Up deadline. I will also have updated forms in Northbrook in June!
